RE: *S. 2311, the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act*

Dear Senator:

On behalf of the over 1.7 million members and supporters of the Faith & Freedom Coalition, I urge you to vote YES on S. 2311, the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act. A vote for this bill is a vote to curtail elective late-term abortions and extend legal protection to pain-capable unborn children nationwide. To that end, **Faith & Freedom Coalition will score the vote on S. 2311 and your vote will appear in tens of millions of Congressional Scorecards and voter guides distributed in over 100,000 churches.**

The United States is currently one of just seven countries – including serial human rights abusers China and North Korea – that permits elective abortion after 20 weeks. It is time to end this obvious and tragic moral wrong.

Twenty states have already passed legislation protecting unborn children beginning at 20 weeks of pregnancy and last year the U.S. House of Representatives passed this vital pro-life legislation to end the abhorrent practice of taking the life of an unborn child after the 20th week of pregnancy when medical science shows the child can feel excruciating pain.

Abortion stops a beating heart and ends an innocent human life. Though legalized by the Supreme Court in 1973, abortion on demand has never rested easy on the collective conscience of the American people and now you have a chance to do something about it.

Faith & Freedom Coalition is a grassroots public policy organization with over 1.7 million members and supporters committed to pro-life and pro-family legislation, criminal justice reform, immigration reform, and education reform at the federal and state level. In 2016, FFC volunteers knocked on 1.2 million doors of social conservative voters in key states, made over 10 million phone calls, sent 22 million pieces of educational mail, and passed out 30 million voter guides in 117,000 churches.
